



GREEN BUILDING INCENTIVE (FEE WAIVER) PROGRAM

At the regular meeting on April 21 2009, the Fullerton City Council unanimously approved resolution number 09-28 to implement a 12 month “Build Green Incentive Program” (Green Improvements), from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.

The features for the “Build Green Incentive Program” include:

- Plan check and inspection/permit fees to be waived for green / energy efficiency upgrades for the following installations:
 - Cogeneration Fuel Cells
 - Cool Roofs where not required by California Energy Code 2007 Edition (CEC2007)
 - Geothermal Heat Pumps
 - Grey Water Systems
 - Windows and doors above CEC 2007 efficiency standards
 - HVAC Systems above CEC 2007 efficiency standards (unit with a SEER of 14 or higher)
 - Insulation above minimum required by CEC 2007
 - Insulation in attics of existing buildings (R-19 or higher)
 - Photovoltaic Systems
 - Renewable Energy Systems
 - Skylights approved by California Energy Commission
 - Tankless Domestic Water Heaters
 - Waterless Urinals
 - Wind Turbines
 - Other Green Installations/Innovations*
