



SR-91 Westbound Lane Widening Project

Nighttime Bridge Demo & Sawcutting Work (Work will generate intermittent noise)

Week of July 15, 2013

As part of Orange County's Measure M Program, Caltrans and OCTA plan to demolish the edge of the westbound SR-91 overpass at Brookhurst Road **July 15 – July 17 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly**. Work will take place behind concrete safety barriers and will require the closure of Brookhurst Road at the SR-91 to provide for the safety of commuters and crews alike.

As a detour, commuters can travel northbound or southbound by using Euclid Street or Magnolia Avenue.

Similar work is planned for Raymond Avenue the evenings of **July 24 and 25**. Work on both overpasses are necessary to make room for the new lane.

Nighttime Sawcutting Activities Planned

Crews will conduct nighttime sawcutting work as needed in different areas of westbound SR-91 from State College Boulevard to Brookhurst Road. To maximize safety and productivity, the work must take place at night during overnight/off-peak hours.

Project Benefits

- One new four-mile lane in the westbound direction between SR-57 and I-5
- Widened crossings at State College, Acacia Avenue, Raymond Avenue, Metrolink Crossing, Euclid Street, Brookhurst Street
- Standardized 12-foot lanes and 8-10 foot shoulders
- New striping, overhead signage and safety barriers
- New improvements to drainage facilities
