**REGULAR BUSINESS**

1. Disabled Person's Parking – 1343 E. Union Avenue  
Consider a request from the property owners at 1343 E. Union Avenue for a disabled person's parking space in front of their residence.

2. Disabled Person's Parking – 402 N. Highland Avenue  
Consider a request from the property owners at 402 N. Highland Avenue for a disabled person's parking space on the north side of Whiting Avenue, immediately east of Highland Avenue, adjacent to 402 N. Highland Avenue.  
Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Approve and recommend to Council.

3. Disabled Person's Parking – 1253 Paseo Dorado  
Consider a request from the property owners at 1253 Paseo Dorado for a disabled person's parking space in front of their residence.  
Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Approve and recommend to Council.
4. Rescind Overnight Parking – Whiting Avenue  
Consider a request to remove the overnight parking restriction (2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.) on both sides of Whiting Avenue, between Malden Avenue and Highland Avenue.  
Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Deny the request.
5. No Stopping Anytime – Orangethorpe Avenue  
Consider installation of "No Stopping Anytime" on the south side of Orangethorpe Avenue from 220 feet west of Euclid Street to Citrus Avenue.  
Recommendation by Engineering Staff: Approve and recommend to Council.
6. No Stopping – Student Loading/Unloading – Ladera Vista Jr. High School
