**Revised Mitigation Measure 4.11-2** 

## 4.11.5 Mitigation Measures

- Impact 4.11-1 Although not currently planned, any potential use of outdoor recreational lighting at the Multiple Use site would subject adjacent residents to intrusive ambient light conditions during periods of nighttime usage, as well as adversely impact nighttime views of the project site.
- MM 4.11-1a The City of Fullerton shall review any proposals for the use of the Multiple Use site, and may impose conditions to mitigate the impact of the use of outdoor recreational lighting in the future.
- MM 4.11-1b All street, signage, and landscape lighting sources shall be shielded to prevent lighting overspill into adjacent residential or natural resource preservation areas.
- Impact 4.11-2 Among the permitted uses in Areas A, B, and COpen Space Area B, the Specific Plan Amendment would allow the construction of communications facilities. Such facilities could include tower structures with the potential to cause adverse visual impacts within various public and private viewsheds.
- MM 4.11-2 All communications facilities proposed in Areas A, B, and COpen Space Area B shall be subject to design review and approval by the City of Fullerton to ensure that unscreened communications towers are not placed within areas of the site that are significant components of public or private viewsheds, that view access to or from the site will not be degraded or obstructed by such facilities, and that habitat conservation areas are not adversely affected.

## 4.11.6 Unavoidable Significant Impacts

With implementation of the design review procedures imposed by the City of Fullerton and the mitigation measures identified in Section 4.11.5, visual impacts associated with the proposed project will remain at a less than significant level.
