# <u>WILLIAMSON AVENUE - 30 MINUTE PARKING</u>

City Traffic Engineer Mark Miller presented this item. The request came from property owners on the north side on Williamson Avenue because of continuous long term parking in front of their businesses. Staff's recommendation was to install 30-minute parking on the north side of Williamson Avenue from Euclid Street to 125 feet west of Woods Avenue, between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Commissioner Simmons asked if there was sufficient parking for employees because cars are parked bumper to bumper on the street.

Dave Langstaff replied that he spoke to the property owners and they stated that they had ample parking for their employees.

Lieutenant Brower stated that most of the cars belong to the auto body shops.

# VALENCIA MESA DRIVE – NO STOPPING ANYTIME

City Traffic Engineer Mark Miller presented this item. Staff's recommendation was to install no stopping anytime on the north side of Valencia Mesa Drive from the centerline of Harbor Boulevard to 288 feet west of Harbor Boulevard. The parking structure and surface lots are completed and the removal of the parking in front of the Bank of America and doctors offices will eliminate the blocked sight distance as cars are exiting the parking lots.

MOTION made by Commissioner Simmons, SECONDED by Commissioner Rizzo, and CARRIED unanimously to install no stopping anytime on the north side of Valencia Mesa Drive.

## CASA BLANCA - NO STOPPING

City Traffic Engineer Mark Miller presented this item. Staff's recommendation was to install no stopping between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, non-school days exempt, on the west side of Casa Blanca Drive between Fern Drive and Barris Drive.

Public comment was opened and closed.

MOTION made by Commissioner Rizzo, SECONDED by Commissioner Park, and CARRIED unanimously to approve the No Stopping Anytime on Casa Blanca.


