FOR HOMELESS ENCAMPMENT AND SITE  
QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

**Q: Who is the current contractor? May we see a copy of their rates?**

A: We do not have a current contractor and therefore do not have rates to share.

**Q: Is this scope of work subject to prevailing wage?**

A: Per the DIR's Determination of Prevailing Wage the cleaning and hauling of waste (including bio-waste) is subject to the public work of "maintenance" thus prevailing wage requirements under section 1771 apply. Our contracted work will be regular and scheduled in nature, related to addressing COVID-19 related safety and public health risk of the community, and include the actual clearing of the site in addition to the collection/hauling away of packaged containers of waste materials. This is a prevailing wage project and upon contract award, the City's Public Works Department will file a DIR PWC 100 Form online.

**Q: Pricing asks to price "biohazard material disposal" (attachment B). What should contractors do if we come across other "hazardous waste" streams, i.e. oils, paints, pesticides, drug paraphernalia? Will we not be asked to package, transport and dispose of such wastes? If we are asked to provide such services, how should we provide such pricing?**

A: The City's expectation is that the contractor will pick up, package, and transport all types of waste that is encountered at the cleanup sites. You may use Line 5 in Section A "Non-Biohazard Material Disposal" to provide such pricing.

**Q: Can you clarify the difference between line items 1 & 2, and line items 3 & 3?**

A. Section A provides multiple pricing options to allow responders flexibility in providing their pricing. You may use whichever lines work for you and leave the others blank.

**Q: Can you clarify the difference between pricing section A and section C? Under what conditions do we bill section A and not C? And vice-versa?**

A: Section A is requesting pricing for regularly scheduled work while Section C is requesting pricing for additional work that is not regularly or pre-scheduled but instead requested on an as-needed basis with a 72-hour notice.

**Q: I noticed that you need to send an email version of the RFP, due to COVID we are not in the office, can we submit completely online?**

**Q: Since the City is issuing this Q & A addendum today will the deadline for submissions be extended?**
